Bylaws of the Home Economics Education Research Lab of Wayo Women's University

Chapter 1. General Provisions

Article 1. (Designations)

The name of the research center shall be the Home Economics Education Research Lab (hereafter, "Lab").

Article 2. (Goals and Aims)

The Lab is a division of the Comprehensive Research Organization of Wayo Women's University. Based on the 125-year history of the Wayo group of educational institutions (*Wayo Gakuen*), the purpose of the Lab is to contribute to the enhancement of home economics education by conducting theoretical and practical research into home economics education, promoting recurrent education for home economics teachers, and establishing a center where people involved in home economics education can work together.

Article 3. (Operations)

The Lab shall carry out the following activities in order to achieve the objectives stated in the preceding article.

1. Organize lectures, workshops, training sessions, etc.

2. Publish newsletters and other publications.

3. Establish a network of home economics teachers which shall disseminate information.

4. Conduct research on the life histories and education practices of home economics teachers from Wayo Women's University and organize the "Wayo Home Economics Archive."

5. Develop home economics teaching materials under the "Wayo" brand.

6. Carry out other activities to achieve the objectives stated in the preceding article.

Chapter 2. (Membership)

Article 4. The members of the Lab shall be regular members, student members, and supporting members

1. Regular member refers to individuals who join the Lab and are in agreement with its objectives.

2. Student member refers to students and graduate students who join the lab and are in agreement with its objectives. Graduate students may choose either regular membership or student membership.

3. Supporting members refers to organizations and corporations, etc., that join the lab and are in agreement whit its objectives, and are supportive of its and projects and activities.

Article 5. (Admission)

Those who wish to become a member of the Lab must submit an application form to the Lab by mail or via electronic media (online application).

Article 6. (Terminating membership)

Those who wish to terminate membership in the Lab must submit a notice of termination to the Lab by mail or via electronic media (online correspondence).

Article 7. Regular members, student members, and supporting members shall have the following rights:

1. To participate in lectures, presentations and workshops.

2. To contribute to and receive the Lab's bulletins, newsletters, etc.

3. To participate in a network of home economics teachers and receive information from the network.

- 4. To Participate in the development of home economics teaching materials.
- 5. To participate in other projects conducted by the Lab.

Supplementary Provision

1. These bylaws shall be in effect as of April 1, 2022.
